## Dock Master, Tom Henry

would like to start by thanking Rick Campbell, Kyle Harris, Bill Huntley, Ron Parent, Mike McCormick, Fritz Peterson, and Dave Collino for coming out on such a cold day for fall clean up and winterization on the water system for the docks. A BIG thank you goes to Kyle Harris for bringing his compressor out for the job on such short notice.

The BAD news is that winterization was not completed due to the early freeze we had. We were able to blow out the supply line up to the check valve. We found the check valve frozen solid, along with all main supply lines to the docks. The check valve was removed and stored to thaw out.

I believe the damage is done because of the several days of below-freezing temperatures. It will be a wait-and-see situation until the spring, when temperatures stabilize, and we can get the water back on to access the damage to the pipes.

If there are any suggestions from the pipe fitters or plumbers at the club, your input would be greatly appreciated!





Nick Burson lives in the Monroe area and enjoys sailing, bicycling, and bowling. Recently retired, he is looking forward to sailing with his wife Laurie.


Jake Geiger lives in Monroe, and works for DTE Energy. In his free time he enjoys his 19' Rinker Captiva, wakeboarding, and softball.




